- Hello, my name is Hilda Flor, the Center Exam Manager of Centro Ecuatoriano Norteamericano in Ecuador.
- We're live streaming in celebration of being the first test center in the region to administer the digital version of the Michigan English Test.
- We're excited and busy preparing to open our doors to 30 registered test takers at 9 AM this morning. Just like our test center, they are pioneers in language testing!
- Now, to familiarize you with our center, let's walk-through the facility, following the path our test takers will be taking shortly.

<Begins walk-through>

- Upon entering the center, our test takers will be instructed to wait in our lobby seating. From there, they will be called and run through a security check before entering the main building.
- Before sitting for MET Digital, test takers will have their photos taken and identity confirmed by our staff.
- They will then enter our secure, COVID-safe lab to sit for MET Digital.
- When a test taker has finished their exam, they will exit and pick up their personal belongings before leaving the building. They will return home and receive their results through the online customer portal within 5 days!
