

GENERIC TALKING POINTS

2. Staying in touch with NPR and local news from WKAR is as easy as 102.3! To ensure you have easy access to all of the news and music programs from WKAR, set two presets: 90.5...and 102.3 FM. *[ok to omit the first sentence if you don't have enough time]*
3. If you missed a story, or if it's more convenient to listen later, you can hear a repeat of All Things Considered later this evening from 6 to 8 over on WKAR NewsTalk
4. Ask your smart speaker to play WKAR-FM
